Dear Parents, Caregivers and Families

NSW Health has identified a confirmed COVID-19 case in the Northern Rivers Region. Contact tracers are investigating and contacting close contacts and venues of concern.

We request that you advise the school immediately should your child/ren be identified by NSW Health contact tracers as a Close Contact and follow the testing and self isolation directions of NSW Health. The school will work to minimise disruption to these students' learning through prepared coursework and will keep parents informed during this time. Under the current Public Health Order, if you have not been advised by NSW Health contact tracers to self-isolate you may continue your normal daily activities.

Our focus is on ensuring that every child in our care is safe, cared for and is able to continue their learning. Families should be confident that all the decisions that have been, and will be made, regarding the impact of COVID-19 on our school community is based on the concern and compassion for every person. Our school remains open for all students to attend and will only move to Blended Learning when directed by NSW Health to do so.

Please remember to use the Service NSW COVID Safe Check-In (QR code) in every location you visit as this is the best mechanism for NSW Health contact tracers for contacting you should you ever visit a confirmed case location.

Anyone who attended venues listed is a [close contact](#) and must immediately [get tested](#) and [self-isolate](#) for 14 days regardless of the result, and call 1800 943 553 unless they have already been contacted by NSW Health.
